Project Description: The Low Flow Toilet Rebate Program consists of a \$50.00 rebate off the purchase of Low Flow Toilets (also called low flush toilets, dual flush toilets or two-button toilets).

- Toilets must use 6-litres or less of water per flush. Dual flush toilets with a 3 litre and 6 litre flush are preferred.
- Limit of one toilet per household per year.
- **An applicant must fill out an application and receive approval from the West Interlake Watershed Conservation District prior to purchasing the low flow toilet.** Once approved for the program, the applicant must submit a proof of purchase (receipt) in order to receive a rebate of \$50.00
- The purchase of Low Flow Toilet must be for the property that is located within the WIWCD boundaries.
- Applications will be assessed on a first-come first-serve basis until program funding runs out.

Low Flow Toilet Rebate Program Criteria

Objective: To conserve water through the replacement from older style toilets (>13 litres of water use per flush) to low flow toilets (<6 litres of water per flush).

Eligibility and Conditions:

1. An applicant must fill out an application and receive approval from the West Interlake Watershed Conservation District prior to purchasing the low flow toilet. Once approved for the program, the applicant will receive a rebate of \$50.00
2. Toilets must be 6-litres or less of water use per flush.
3. Limit of one toilet per household per year.
4. Applicants are responsible for the proper disposal of the old toilets.
5. Applicants must be in good financial standing with the WIWCD.

The West Interlake Watershed Conservation District:

1. Will not be held responsible for the disposal of old toilets.
