Terms and Conditions

Eligibility

- All projects must be approved by the Conservation District prior to construction and/or installation.
- Land must be within the WIWCD
- The water body must normally be used for watering of livestock and livestock must be excluded from drinking directly from water source
- Lake shore is excluded from this program
- Allow for at least a thirty (30) foot buffer strip or distance agreed to by board between water and livestock
- The WIWCD will pay 75% of total project cost up to a maximum refund of \$ 5,000.00 for dugouts and \$ 10,000.00 for waterways with the exception of installation of fence. Landowner responsible for the cost of installation of fence
- The cheque will be issued to applicant after the project is completed and inspected by WIWCD representative.
- One application per landowner per year, dependant on Board approval

Roles and Responsibilities

The Applicant Shall:

- 1. Design and build the project in cooperation with District staff and/or other partner organizations such Manitoba Habitat Heritage Corporation (MHHC)
- Be responsible for required maintenance following the completion of the project and agree to leave the project in place for a minimum of ten (10) years. After ten years, all materials purchased and/or installed will become the property of the landowner
- 3. Grant consent of entry to the District, its agents, servants, and/or employees with the necessary equipment for inspection, advertisement of the project and the right to publish the applicant's name.
- 4. Not alter, remove, or modify the project without written consent of the District
- 5. Indemnify and save harmless the WIWCD, their agents, engineers, servants, and/or employees from any liability which may result from this project

The WIWCD Shall:

1. Provide technical advice, funding and project supervision

General Information

The annual projects resulting from this program are subject to available annual funding. The Conservation District will determine application priorities in consultation with Sub District members and District staff. <u>All projects must be approved by the Conservation District prior to construction and/or installation.</u>
