Terms and Conditions

Eligibility

- All projects must be approved by the Conservation District prior to construction and/or installation.
- Land must be within the WIWCD
- The WIWCD will fund up to \$1,000.00 (plus GST) for abandoned well sealing
- The WIWCD will fund up to \$1,000.00 (plus GST) for flowing well
- The WIWCD will fund 50% up to \$ 500.00 (plus GST) for well head upgrades
- One application per registered landowner per year, dependant on Board approval

Roles and Responsibilities

The Applicant shall:

- 1. Grant consent of entry to the District, its agents, servants, and/or employees with the necessary equipment for inspection, advertisement of the project and the right to publish applicant's name.
- 2. Not alter, remove, or modify the project without written consent of the District
- 3. Indemnify and save harmless the WIWCD, their agents, engineers, servants, and/or employees from any liability which may result from this project
- 4. Allow signage to be placed at project site
- 5. Be responsible for the remaining costs (plus GST) over the Conservation District maximum of \$1,000.00 for abandoned well sealing and flowing wells and \$500.00 for well head upgrades.

The WIWCD shall:

1. Provide technical advice, funding and project supervision

General Information

The annual projects resulting from this program are subject to available annual funding. The Conservation District will determine application priorities in consultation with sub district members and district staff. **All projects must** be approved by the Conservation District prior to construction and/or installation.
